**RE: ForeseeHome Medical Device Travel Support Letter**

Transportation Security Administration (TSA) Personnel:

This letter is being provided on behalf of a patient being co-managed by the ForeseeHome AMD Monitoring Program through Medicare Provider and Independent Diagnostic Testing Facility, the Notal Vision Monitoring Center.

The ForeseeHome device is a medical monitoring device used by patients diagnosed with Age-Related Macular Degeneration (AMD). The device supports ongoing home monitoring as prescribed by the patient's eye care professional.

The patient may be traveling with the following equipment and accessories:

- ForeseeHome monitoring device
- Power cord and power supply
- Mouse or input accessory
- Communication modem or related connectivity accessory (if applicable)

Pursuant to Transportation Security Administration (TSA) guidance regarding assistive devices, medically necessary equipment, and electronic medical devices permitted through security checkpoints, this equipment may require separate screening but is permitted for transport by passengers traveling by air.

The device is safe for airline travel and airport screening procedures. We kindly request your assistance in allowing the patient to transport this medical equipment through security screening. Whenever possible, we recommend that the patient keep the device in their carry-on luggage to help prevent damage during transport.
